



Hell's Poker Shooting schedule – shooting schedule set to be revised and updated to include 2 location production and filming, remote and virtual production and filming. This shooting schedule is for reference only at this time.

Day 1

- 1.1. Contestants arrive at airport they are picked up and taken to host location (Casino Hotel).
- 1.2. Contestants are directed to meet in the Series Conference Room.
- 1.3. Once all contestants have arrived they are placed into 1 of 3 teams.
- 1.4. Contestants will be assigned rooms and roommates, they will then check into their rooms.
- 1.5. After contestants have checked into their rooms they will meet back in the Series Conference Room
- 1.6. Series Meeting with all contestants, Producer, Production Staff, Host Location Representatives & Security.
 - 1.6.1. Introduction of all Production Staff, Host Location Staff and Contestants are made.
 - 1.6.2. Casino – Hotel host location representative goes over host location rules with the contestants to include host location security explaining location security rules.
 - 1.6.3. Contestant Coordinator goes over living, eating, emergency, Series play time, free time and emergence procedures with the contestants. Series Coordinator will hold a short Q& A to answer Contestants questions.
 - 1.6.4. Contestants are given a player package which includes:

- 1.6.4.a. Series Schedule & welcome letter
- 1.6.4.b. Series Host location and event map
- 1.6.4.c. Series Production, Coordinator & Host location contact numbers and personal listings.
- 1.6.4.d. Series Identity Credentials
- 1.6.4.e. Cell phone with 2-way radio service.
- 1.6.4.f. Series Rules
- 1.6.4.g. Host Location Rules
- 1.6.4.h. Emergency Procedure Information
- 1.6.4.i. \$300.00 in spending money (additional money given to contestants throughout the duration of the Series for spending money).
- 1.6.4.j. Series shirts, hats and other apparel.
- 1.6.4.k. Meal & Transportation passes

1.7. Series Meeting will break for lunch. Buffet lunch where teams will eat at the same table; first informal meeting for teams.

1.8. Series Meeting resumes with contestants assembling in teams for meeting.

1.8.1 Production Staff goes over Series Rules, weekly play, pro Series play, celebrity guest play and rules.

1.8.2. Contestants are briefed on what is expected of them each day to include daily writing in their video blogs. (Each room is equipped with a laptop and internet access to player blogs with web cam. Each contestant is required to write in their player blog daily. Instruction of how to use the laptop to write in their blogs is given at this time.

1.8.3. Contestants are briefed on the role of teams in regards to team selection and voting each week for deciding on which team members will play together at a table; and other aspects of team play and actions. Teams will be assigned team areas and meeting times.

1.9. Series Meeting breaks and resumes in the Series Table Play Area where filming and play will occur.

1.9.1. Contestants will be given a tour of the Series play area.

1.9.2. Contestants will be given a tour of the Host Location and locations of the Team Player Meeting areas.

1.9.3. A brief Q & A session will be held for contestants.

1.20. Contestants are given a break to go to their rooms to get acquainted with their roommates, rest and get ready for the Series Dinner event.

1.20.1. Closed dinner for contestants which includes meeting Series professionals, guest speakers and guest celebrity guests. Entertainment by hosts.

1.21. Dinner ends contestants return to their rooms and have no scheduled events or meeting for the remainder of the evening. Contestants are encouraged to remain in their rooms, write in their blogs and rest for the next day activities.

Day 2

2.1. Contestants have an open breakfast period where they can meet with other team members, roommates or do what they want for breakfast at the host location.

2.2. Contestants meet at the Series Play Table location.

2.2.1. Contestants are separated into their respective teams and 3 members from each team is placed at a Series table for a total of 9 players at each table. (During play contestants are referred to as players).

2.2.2. Contestants are given an introduction speech by the Series Commissioner, introduced to the Series announcers, hosts, table officials, dealers and pro players again in the Series play setting.

2.2.3. Contestants are given a dry run of how the days Series play will proceed. This will go on several times until players and Series Announcers Team members to include production are all comfortable with the mechanics of the taping of the weekly Series play.

2.2.4. Players break for a buffet style lunch.

2.3. Players return to the Series play tables for the afternoon practice play.

2.4. Players return to their respective seats from the morning dry run of weekly Series play.

2.4.1. Practice Series play is started.

2.4.2. Play is commenced at the 3 Series tables as if players were participating in the weekly Series. This is a time for players to ask questions, practice team and individual strategies, ask help from the pros and see how their play is against the other contestants. Further a dry taping of the Series play will be done at this time for production and players to get acclimated to working together.

2.4.3. Practice play will go on until only one player is left at each table.

2.4.4. Each player remaining at each table will then have a practice Series match against of the Series Professional in a mock Pro Series Match.

2.4.5. A final review of the events and table play of the contestants will be made.

2.5. End of Practice Series Play

2.6. Players are released to their rooms for free time.

2.7. Players meet for dinner with their respective teams and will eat with teams.

2.8. After dinner players will meet with their respective teams in their team rooms. This is a time for teams to get initially strategies discussed, interact with other team members, build alliances and map start the process of deciding which team members will play together at the next day's Series play.

2.8.1. Series Team members and Series coordinator will meet with each team respectively and go over what is expected of them as a team. Q & A time for teams.

2.9. End of day 2, players are required to write in their blogs then have free time to do what they want to.

Day 3 (Televised as week 1 of Series)

3.1. All contestants, production staff & Series Team members meet for buffet style breakfast in preparation for the start of the Official Series Play.

3.2. End of breakfast.

3.3. Players separate into their respective teams and report to their team Meeting Areas to decide between them which team members will play with together at that days Series play. Teams will also take this time to discuss their strategy for that days Series play. Teams must write their team player table lines up on the Series play team sheet. It will be picked up by the Series host and delivered to the chairman.

3.4. End of Team meetings, player will have a short break; they then report to the Series Play Table area for the start of the Official Series Weekly Play.

3.4.1. The host of the Series will be introduced and will greet everyone and open the show. The host will direct that evenings proceedings and will introduce the

commissioner, the announcers, the Series Team and the Series Pros while each enters and takes their place at the Series.

3.4.2. The contestants will then be introduced in teams and enter one team at a time.

3.4.3. Each team will have its members stand behind one of the Series play tables.

3.4.4. Each team member will have their name on a gold plate on the back of the seat at the table they will be playing at.

3.4.5. The chairman then announces which team group will play at which table. If a team cannot make a decision as to which players would play together the chairman will make the decision for them.

3.4.6. Players are then directed to take their seats at the appropriate table by the announcers. On their way to their respective tables' players are given their Series play chips.

3.4.6.a. During the Series celebrity guests will sit in at tables and play against the Series players. Celebrity Guest players will be introduced by the announcers and be escorted in by two host location show persons.

3.4.5. Once all players are seated the announcers will then give a brief overview of Series play. The announcers will ask each table if they are ready to begin play, upon a positive response from the tables the chair will announce, "Begin the Series"

3.4.6. The dealers will then begin dealing the cards (ensuring small and big blinds are paid).

3.4.7. Play continues until one person is out of Series chips and is removed from the game. That player must then get up from the table remove the gold name plate from the back of their chair, walk across the Series floor to a position in front of the chairman and drop their gold name plate into the loser's box; then proceed to walk out of the Series play room letting the doors close behind them. (*Each week one player from each team is protected from elimination by being the previous week table winner or by being given protection by the previous week winner).

3.4.8. All play stops as the losing player proceeds to leave the Series; and starts again when the doors close behind the losing player. The announcers will announce the start and stopping of play.

3.4.9. Play then continues until there is one winner at each table. As each player loses they get up and go sit in the team spectator seating. The winner at each table will

advance to the Pro Series and is also granted protection from elimination for the next day of Series play.

3.4.10. Series play for that day is then announced as ended by the Chairman.

3.5. Players are excused to go to dinner and take a short break thereafter.

3.6. Players then return to the Series Play area to participate in the Pro Series or to watch as the Celebrity Guest Players Series the Series Pros.

3.6.1. The three winners from that day's play are then introduced and asked to sit at their respective tables. Their gold name plates are on the back of their respective chairs, not having been removed from their chairs after the earlier days Series play.

3.6.1.a. During normal Series play a celebrity guest player may win at a table. If this is the case for a specific table the celebrity guest player will then play against the professional in the Pro Series. The celebrity guest player would then be introduced and take their place at the respective Pro Series Table.

3.6.2. The announcers then announce the entry into the room of the 3 Series Professionals. Each Professional stands at their respective tables as they are introduced by the announcers. Once announced the Professional takes their respective seats.

3.6.3. The professional at each table takes out \$10,000 in cash and throws it on their respective tables. Each Professional makes a short intimidating statement directed to the player challenging them.

3.6.4. Once both parties are seated the announcers will give a brief overview of the Pro Series rules.

3.6.5. The Chairman will then announce the start of the Pro Series.

3.6.6. During the Pro Series both parties are allowed to talk trash to the other player.

3.6.7. Play continues until one player wins the Pro Series.

3.6.7.a. If the Series Pro or Celebrity Guest Player wins the Pro Series; the \$10,000 cash is given to a charity of their choice.

3.6.7.b. If the player wins the Pro Series they are given the \$10,000 cash to be divided equally between their respective team members.

3.6.8. Once the Pro Series is completed the Winner will stand up from their table, shake hands with the Series Professional; then walk to a position next to the commissioner. The winner will then be handed the \$10,000 cash by the Series Host.

3.6.8.a If the Series Pro or Celebrity Guest Player wins the host will do a short interview with the winner and the commissioner will hand them the \$10,000 cash.

3.6.8.b. If a Series player wins they will be interviewed by the Series host and handed the \$10,000 cash by the Series commissioner.

3.6.8.c. The Series player who wins the Pro Series has 3 options to them.

1) Go for Double or nothing for the whole amount, on a single cut of the deck against the beautiful co-host/interviewer. If they lose they lose it all, If the player wins they get double the money they won.

If the winner doubles the money he has two options at that time.

2) Keep the money he won in the Pro Series for themselves.

3). Share the money equally with his team members

3.6.8.d. The team members of the winning player meet at one of the Series tables where they celebrate the winning. The winner equally divides the \$10,000 cash evenly between their team members and gives them their share of the prize cash.

3.7. The Pro Series play ends with the announcers closing the show.

3.8. End of Series play for the day (24 contestants remaining).

3.9. Players have open time to do what they want to but must meet their Series obligations, blog etc.

Day 4 (Televised as week 2 of Series)

4.1. Same schedule as day 3 (21 contestants remaining at end of day)

Day 5 (Televised as week 3 of Series)

5.1. Same schedule as day 3 (18 contestants remaining at end of day)

Day 6 (No Series play)

6.1. Free day for contestants to take a break from the daily Series play.

6.2. Contestants can schedule massages, salon and spa treatments, sightseeing tour of Las Vegas.

6.3. In the evening contestants will meet in the Series Meeting Room where they will be informed of the night's activities, to include attending a Las Vegas Show, dinner at a specialty restaurant, then a night out on the town, making appearances at different Las Vegas night club attractions.

6.4. Contestants will assemble in front of the host location for departure in limos for the evening's activities.

6.5. At completion of evening activities all contestants return to host location via limos for the end of the evening and Series day. Contestants must still complete entry into their daily blogs.

Day 7 (Televised as week 4 of Series)

7.1. Same schedule as day 3 (15 contestants remaining at end of day)

Day 8 (Televised as week 5 of Series)

8.1. Same schedule as day 3 (12 contestants remaining at end of day)

Day 9 (Televised as week 6 of Series)

9.1. Same schedule as day 3 (9 contestants remaining at end of day)

9.2. Remaining 9 contestants are the finalist in the Series and will advance to the SERIES Final Table.

9.3 At the end day 9 Series the announcers will re-introduce the 9 remaining finalist and introduce them as the SERIES Final Table Players.

Day 10 (No Series play)

10.1. Free day for contestants to take a break before the final day of Series play.

10.2. The final contestants will meet midday in front of the host location to be taken by limo to go shopping for attire to wear at the final table.

10.3. After shopping contestants will go to lunch as a group.

10.4. Contestants will return to the host location where they will proceed to the Series main room for interviews and pre-final play instructions.

10.5. Contestants are released for the rest of the day to do what they want to, to prepare for the next day's final table play.

Day 11- Final day of Series Play (Televised as final week 7 of Series)

11.1. Contestants have until mid-day before reporting to a private pre-final brunch where they will eat a light meal and receive final instructions for the days Final table Play.

11.2. Contestants will return to their rooms for a short break and to dress for the days final table play.

11.3. Contestants will proceed, dressed appropriately for play to the final table play area and report to the Series coordinator for check in.

11.4. Start of Final Series

11.4.1. All Production and SERIES Staff will be in place when contestants arrive.

11.4.2. In the Series play room there will be only one final table; on the back of each chair at the final table will be the players gold name plate. The dealer will already be seated. On the table in front of each players seat will be a stack of final table Series play chips for each player on the final table.

11.4.3. The host of the Series will be introduced and will greet everyone and open the final show. The host will direct the evenings proceedings and will introduce the commissioner, the announcers, the SERIES Team and the SERIES Pros while each enters and takes their place at the final Series.

11.4.4. The contestants will then be introduced and enter one at a time by the Series host, each will come up to the host shake hands and take their place at the final table.

11.4.5. When all the final contestants have been introduced and are at the final table they will be instructed to take their seat and get ready to begin play in the SERIES finals.

11.4.6. To the right of the final table and to the rear a stand will be in place prior to the contestant's entry. Upon cue host entertainers will bring in the 1-million-dollar cash prize on golden platters in stacks of bills that are placed onto the stand for all to see.

11.4.7. The Series host will announce the arrival and placement of the prize money.

11.4.8. The host will then announce the placement of the PC Championship ring as it is brought out and placed on the stand.

11.4.9. The host will then introduce the Location Host representatives and thank them for being the host and home of the SERIES.

11.4.9.a. Host Location representative will give a brief statement.

11.4.10.b. SERIES Host will present Series Plaque to Host location representative thanking them for hosting the Series and awarding them the Championship Belt.

11.4.10. The host will announce that it is the custom of the commissioner to start the Series but for the final a special celebrity guest will announce the start of play for the final Series on behalf of the host location. The special celebrity guest will be introduced.

11.4.11. The special celebrity guest host will announce the start of the Series. With that announcement the final table will begin play by the dealing of the cards.

11.4.12. The dealer will start dealing the cards and the final table play will begin.

11.4.13. One by one the players will be eliminated from the final table. Until one player remains at the final table with all the Series play chips.

11.4.14. When one player remains and the final winning hand is dealt and turned over the winning table area will have confetti dropped from the ceiling on the table and player.

11.4.15. The host and commissioner will move to the final table and the winning player. The player will be congratulated and the host will announce the arrival of the final \$1,000,000 prize money which will have been moved from the stand to the final table to be dumped on the table itself in front of the winner.

11.4.16. The commissioner will then award the winner the Series Championship ring and belt and announce the new Series Champion.

11.4.17. The winner will be asked to speak and make a statement.

11.4.18. The host will end the show and Series.

11.4. At the conclusion of the Series the Million Dollar Series will host a celebration party for all persons involved with the Series where media will be doing interviews.

Day 12

12.1. This is a media day and checkout of host location for remaining contestants.
